

Statement of Deficiencies

1915.A.: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915.A.: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915.A. Based on record review: S4 "Infant Room" did not document observations, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. There was no documentation of a observation log in the infant room on the following dates: 7/26/19, 7/29/19, 7/30/19, 7/31/19, 8/1/19, 8/2/19, 8/5/19 and 8/6/19.

1921.E.: Tornado Drills

Not Met

1921.E.: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921.E. Based on record review:
S1 did not have documentation of tornado drills that were conducted at least once per month during the months of April 2019, May 2019, and June 2019. S1 provided documentation that one tornado drill was conducted March 19, 2019
