1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
- 2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

1507-A Based on record review:

The center's daily attendance record for children did not accurately reflect the children on the child care premises at any given time as 74 children were present and 71 children were signed in on the log.

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

1903-C Based on observations:

The outdoor area was not free of hazards as specialists observed two missing wooden planks on roof of playhouse in the two year old outside play yard. Specialist observed four exposed nails that are accessible to children.
