7305-I Based on record review:

The center's staff daily attendance record did not accurately reflect persons on the child care premises at any given time. NEW FINDINGS INCLUDE:

On 8/12/13 Specialist observed 10 staff present in building #1 and 11 staff signed in. S1 was signed into Building #1 but was at Big Summer Camp, which is not part of Licensing buildings. Director walked over to the Big Summer Camp to have S1 sign out.

7327-A: Locked Harmful Substances and Equipment

Finding:

FINDINGS INCLUDE:

Specialist observed in the summer camp building a cabinet unlocked containing bleach solution and liquid starch that stated on bottle to keep out of reach of children.

7327-J: All areas of the center used by the children, including sleep areas, shall be properly heated, cooled, and ventilated.

7327-J Based on observations: Areas of the center used by the children, including sleep areas, were not properly cooled. FINDINGS INCLUDE: Centers Air conditioner was out in parts of the building and it was extremely warm in these areas.
