

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-M: Strings and Cords

Not Met

1901-M: Strings and cords, including but not limited to those found on equipment, window coverings, televisions and radios, shall be inaccessible to children under age 4.

Finding:

1901-M Based on observations: Strings and cords were accessible to children under age 4 as specialist observed two radio cords hanging from a shelf accessible to ten two year old children in the classroom. Deficiency was corrected during visit as S1 secured cords .

1901-Q: The Safety Box

Not Met

1901-Q: The center shall post a copy of the current The Safety Box newsletter issued by the Louisiana Office of the Attorney General and shall immediately remove from the early learning premises any items listed as recalled.

Finding:

1901-Q Based on observations: The Provider did not post 'The Safety Box' newsletter issued by the Louisiana Office of the Attorney General.

1909-G: Infant - Bibs

Not Met

1909-G: Bibs shall not be worn by any child while asleep.

Finding:

1909-G Based on observations: The provider allowed a bib to be worn by a child while asleep. Deficiency was corrected during licensing visit as S3 removed bib from infant.

2103-E: Master Transportation Log

Not Met

2103-E: Master Transportation Log

1. A copy of the current master transportation log shall be maintained on file at the center and shall include the names of the children, the pickup and drop off locations, and the authorized persons to whom the children may be released. Documentation shall be maintained whether transportation is provided by the center or contracted.
2. Each driver or monitor, whether provided by the center or through a contractor, shall be provided a current master transportation log,

Finding:

2103-E Based on record review/interview:

A current copy of the master transportation log was not maintained on file at the center to include the names of the children, the pickup and drop off locations, the authorized persons to whom the children may be released as the only copy of the transportation log is kept in the transportation vehicle accessible to the driver.

2103-F: Passenger Transportation Log

Not Met

2103-F: Passenger Log

1. A current passenger log for each trip shall be used to track children and staff during transportation.
2. The log shall be maintained on file at the center and a copy shall be provided to the driver or monitor.
3. The following shall be recorded in the passenger log:
 - a. date the transportation is provided;
 - b. name of the child;
 - c. name of driver and staff members;
 - d. pick up and drop off locations;
 - e. time child was placed on the vehicle;
 - f. time child was released and name of the person or entity to whom child was released; and
 - g. signature of staff person completing the log.

Finding:

2103-F Based on record review: The Center's current Passenger transportation log provided to the center driver or attendant was incomplete as it did not include time child was placed on the vehicle and name of the person or entity to whom child was released. S1 states children are placed on the center transportation vehicle at 8:20 am; however daily transportation record did not reflect this time.
