

## **Statement of Deficiencies**

### **1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training**

**Not Met**

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### **Finding:**

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: On 8/13/2019 at approximately 1:43pm, S1 did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. 0 of 4 staff members have current medication administration training. S2 stated the guy they use for CPR and First Aid stated he does not offer Medication training. S2 attempted to sign up with Agenda For Children last week, however the class filled up quickly. S2 stated she will continue to work on getting the medication training done.

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
