1901-J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.&K.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. As evident by in the boy's bathroom there was a large bag of potting soil and a box reynold's foil. In the girls bathroom there was a gallon of clorox, a gallon of germacidal ultra bleach and a gallon of dawn detergent.

1921-E: Tornado Drills

Not Met

1921-E: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921-E Based on record review: The provider did not have documentation of tornado drills that were conducted at least once per month during the months of March, April, May, and June. Date of tornado drills were April and May. The provider lacked having conducted a drill in the Month of March. The facility is closed in June.
