## 1711.H.: Rest Time - Minimum Child to Staff Ratio

- 1711.H.: Rest Time Minimum Child to Staff Ratios
- 1. Sufficient staffing needed to satisfy child to staff ratios shall be present on the premises during rest time and available to assist as needed.
- 2. Children ages one and older may be grouped together at rest time with one staff member in each room supervising the resting children.

## Finding:

\*\*NEW\*\*1711.H. Based on observations/interview: At approximately 12:05pm, S1 failed to have the required staffing present in the building during rest time to satisfy child to staff ratio for children present at the center. Specialist observed S1 with 16 children (2 - one-year-olds, 2 - two-year-olds, 12 - three-year-olds) in the classroom by herself. Another staff was needed to meet the ratio. S1 stated S4 left the center for her lunch break and would return shortly. S4's attendance log shows she clocked out at 12:00pm for her lunch break. At approximately 12:56pm, S4 was observed entering the center. S4's attendance log shows she clocked in at 1:00pm. Sufficient staffing to satisfy child to staff ratio was corrected once S4 returned to the center.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective today, S1 stated she will schedule additional staff during rest time/lunch time to satisfy the child to staff ratio.
