

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-C: End-of-Day Check

Not Met

1901-C: The entire center and play yard shall be checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left at the center and this check shall be documented. Documentation shall include date, time of visual check, and signature of the staff conducting the visual check.

Finding:

1901-C Based on record review:

The Provider did not document that the entire center and play yard is checked after the last child departs to ensure that no child is left unattended at the center on the following days 6/2/2017, 6/13/17, 8/10/17, and 8/11/17.

1907-E.2: Cribs Free of Toys and Other Soft or Loose Bedding

Not Met

1907-E.2: Cribs shall be free of toys and other soft or loose bedding, including comforters, blankets, sheets, bumper pads, pillows, stuffed animals and wedges when the child is in the crib.

Finding:

1907-E.2 Based on observations:

The center's cribs were not free of toys or other soft or loose bedding (including comforters, blankets, sheets, bumper pads, pillows, stuffed animals and wedges) while the child was in the crib as evidence by specialist observed one child laying in bed with loose bedding and 2 infants with toys in their crib. S2 stated that she was not aware of this regulation.

1909-B: Infants Placed on Backs for Sleeping

Not Met

1909-B: All infants shall be placed on their backs for sleeping.

1. Written authorization from a physician is required for any other sleeping position.
2. Written notice of the specifically authorized sleeping position shall be posted on or near the crib.

Finding:

1909-B Based on observations: Written authorization from a physician was not available for 3 infants as required for infant to sleep in a different sleeping position. Specialist observed 3 infants sitting in bouncers inside of crib. S2 stated that the center was never informed that the bouncers could not be inside of the crib.

1911-G: Pacifier Attached

Not Met

1911-G: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

Finding:

1911-G Based on observations: A pacifier that was attached to strings or ribbons was attached to the clothing of a child.
