## Statement of Deficiencies

1713-A.-C.: Supervision Not Met

1713-A.-C.: A: Children shall be supervised at all times in the center, on the playground, on field trips, on non-vehicular excursions, and during all water activities and water play activities.

B: Children shall not be left alone in any room, (except the restroom as indicated in Subsection G of this Section or when being provided services by therapeutic professionals, as deficed in 103), outdoors, or in vehicles, even momentarily, without staff present.

C: A staff person shall be assigned to supervise specific children whose names and whereabouts that staff person shall know and with whom the staff person shall be physically present. Staff shall be able to state how many children are in their care at all times.

## Finding:

1713-A.-C. Based on record review: Children were not supervised at all times in the center as evidenced by review of video footage during a visit to the center on 08/21/2018. S1 submitted a critical incident report to Licensing State Office on 08/06/18 in regards to C1 having a lip injury in the classroom at 9:04 am resulting in medical attention being sought. Specialist reviewed video footage of the classroom for 08/06/2018 in an effort to determine the cause of the injury. Specialist began watching the footage at 8:58 am and observed there was no teacher present in the classroom supervising the children. S7 was observed walking into the classroom at 9:00:17 am. Specialist then observed S7 walking out of the classroom at 9:00:34 am leaving the children unsupervised and returning back to the classroom at 9:01:48 am. Specialist observed S7 walk out of the classroom at 9:02:21leaving the children unsupervised, and return at 9:03:09 am. Specialist then observes S7 walk to an area of the classroom not in view of the camera at 9:03:39, and returns in camera view at 9:03:46 am holding C1's hand. S7 is observed wiping C1's face at 9:04 am.
