

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1713-A&B&C: Supervision

Not Met

1713-A&B&C: A: Children shall be supervised at all times in the center, on the playground, on field trips, on non-vehicular excursions, and during all water activities and water play activities.

B: Children shall not be left alone in any room, (except the restroom as indicated in Subsection G of this Section or when being provided services by therapeutic professionals, as defined in 103), outdoors, or in vehicles, even momentarily, without staff present.

C: A staff person shall be assigned to supervise specific children whose names and whereabouts that staff person shall know and with whom the staff person shall be physically present. Staff shall be able to state how many children are in their care at all times.

#### Finding:

NEW 1713.A: Based on observations: Children were not under supervision at all times as evidenced by at approximately 2:50pm, specialist observed three children age one year old sleeping in a separate room with an adjoining door not within sight of S1. S1 was observed sitting on the floor near the wall in the other adjoining room supervising three children ages 8 months to 1 year old. S1 stated she was walking between the two rooms however, specialist observed her sitting on the floor where she was unable to see the three children in the adjoining room. Corrected during the licensing inspection.

### 1911-K: Hand Washing

Not Met

1911-K: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911-K Based on observations: Seven children ages three years old who were being supervised by S5 did not wash their hands using soap as needed. Licensing Specialist observed the children sitting at the table eating afternoon snack, and the children did not wash their hands prior to eating their snack which was at approximately 3:15pm.
