

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725. A-C. Based on record review/interview: At approximately 1:35pm, S1 failed to have documentation that at least two staff members were trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1's current medication administration training certificate expired on 3/23/2021. She stated she is scheduled for medication administration training on 8/28/2021.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 8/24/2021, S1 stated in addition to setting a 90-day reminder of when the training expires, she will have S3 double check all staff folders and create a tracker of when medication administration training expires, so she is not cited for this deficiency again.
