Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C.: Based on Specialist's review of records at 11:30 a.m., S1 failed to have at least two staff members with a current medication administration certification, whether the early learning center administers medication or not. According to center records, staff needed to renew their certification on or before 4/13/2021, to remain valid.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 8/26/2021, to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited, S1 contacted her course trainer to schedule a class as soon as possible; class to be taken before 9/26/2021, with certificates available for review at the next Licensing visit.
