Illness/unusual behavior occurred while child was in the center at night time on 5/11/12 and the parent notification was Unknown. S1 stated 5/11/12 parent was notified although unsure of time and center failed to properly document the incident on 5/11/12, second time parent was notified parent picked C1 up at 8:31p. Documentation on report for C1 did not include the following: type/description of illness, date and time of onset and actions taken, time of parental notification and signature of person notifying the parent.
