Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.A&B: Based on observations on 09/04/19 at 11:05AM, S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 2 of 5 staff had documentation of this certification.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on observations on 09/04/19 at 11:05AM, S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 2 of 5 staff had documentation of this certification.

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations on 09/04/19 at 10:14AM, the outdoor area was not free of hazards as evidenced by there are two Cozy Coupe missing the steering wheels on the playground. S2 placed the Cozy Coupe's on the outside of the fence while specialist was present.

1915.A.: Health Services - Observation

1915.A.: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915.A. Based on record review on 09/04/19 at 11:52AM, the staff at the center did not document an explanation from parent and/or child when the they noticed possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed. Specialist reviewed observations logs from 08/01/2019 - 09/03/19 and this information was not documented in either of the three classrooms.
