S1 was the only staff on the premises with current certification in infant and Child CPR on 9/5/17. The center failed to have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in adult CPR. 1 of 8 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 was the only staff on the premises with current certification in adult CPR on 9/5/17.
