1903.E.5.: Outdoor - Enclosed

Not Met

1903.E.5.: Outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons.

Finding:

1903.E.5. Based on record review: At approximately 8:30am, S1's outdoor front entrance lacked an enclosure with a permanent fence or other permanent barrier in a manner that protects children from traffic hazards, prevents children from leaving the premises without proper supervision, and prevents contact with animals or unauthorized persons. Near the front entrance door are steps, a ramp and a busy street. There are two additional doors that leads into the center's classrooms next to the front door entrance. At approximately 8:39am, S1 stated that she has spoken to her maintenance man and that he is currently working on building a gate that will prevent children from exiting off the center's premises and into traffic. S1 stated that the gate should be up by the end of this weekend. S1 also stated that when the children are leaving out of the second door a teacher stands by the door while the children are walking out. S1 stated that there is usually one teacher in the front of the line of children and one in the back.
