

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-J.-K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.-K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-J.-K. Based on observations on 09/10/2018, plastic bags not in use were not made inaccessible to children as evidence by: specialist observed one large plastic shopping bag that contained several smaller plastic shopping bags and one 7 inch personal clip-on fan box that also contained several plastic shopping bags located in the unlocked white cabinet underneath the sink in the infant room. S1 removed prior to specialist departure.

1903-E.4: Outdoor - Kitchen

Not Met

1903-E.4: Children shall not enter or exit the center through the kitchen.

Finding:

1903-E.4 Based on observations /interviews on 09/10/2018, while conducting a walk through of the center specialist observed the only direct exit to the playground was an exit through the kitchen. Per S1's statement, the children enter and exit through the kitchen to get to the playground.
