# Statement of Deficiencies

## 1901-J.-K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

1901-J.-K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

### Finding:

1901-J. Based on observations: Items that can be harmful to children, such as cleaning supplies/chemicals were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Specialist observed a bottle of cleaning solution underneath the changing table in the nursery. The door to the changing table was not locked. Cleaning solution was moved to a secured location during Licesning visit.

### 1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

#### Finding:

1901-P Based on observations: The personal belongings of center staff member, S4, was accessible to children. S4's purse was located on a shelf, which was accessible to children, in the 1-2 year old classroom. Purse was moved to a secured location during Licensing visit.
