

Statement of Deficiencies

7312-E.3: PFA

Not Met

7312-E.3: A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to children shall have documentation of current pediatric first aid certification. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This certification shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

Finding:

The Provider did not have documentation that at least 50 percent of the staff on the premises and accessible to children at all times has current approved Pediatric First Aid training. Per the center's staff attendance logs in conjunction with their PFA documentation, the facility failed to have 50% of staff with documentation of this training for certain times the last 3 days as follows:

9/17/13: from 11:30am through 2pm, there was 1 of 4 staff with this documented training

9/16/13: from 11:30am through 2pm, there was 1 of 4 staff with the documented training

9/13/13: from 10am through 3:30pm, there was 2 of 5 staff; from 3:30pm through 4pm, there was 1 of 4 staff; and from 4pm through 5pm, there was 1 of 3 staff with this documented training.

Upon discussing this with the director, she stated she believed S2 had this training. Specialist showed the director this staff member had Healthcare Provider training from the American Heart Association which does not include Pediatric First Aid Training. The director spoke with the staff member who stated she believes she received Pediatric First Aid training along with the CPR/AED she received. Specialist discussed with the director several options how to meet this regulation's requirements.
