1911-G: Pacifier Attached

Not Met

1911-G: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

Finding:

1911-G Based on record review: A pacifier that was attached to strings or ribbons was attached to the clothing of a child and a pacifier was attached to a stuffed animal. The Specialist observed during the initial walk through of the center, two one year old children with pacifiers attached to a cord and attached to a stuffed animal. This was corrected during the visit.

1919-A&B: Food Service and Nutrition - Menu

1919-A&B: All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and 7 C.F.R. 226.20 and the Louisiana Sanitary Code, Title 51, Part XXIII, found at LAC 51:XXXIII. For the current CACFP meal patterns, contact the Louisiana Department of Education, Division of Nutrition Support.

The weekly menu shall:

1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week; and
3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

Finding:

1919 A & B Food Service and Nutrition-Menu:The Current weekly menu listing specific food items served for each day of the week was not prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week. There was no weekly menu posted for the current week.
