NEW 1715-A.1.3. Based on record review: The Provider did not have documentation of termination or resignation of employment, the last date of employment, reason for leaving, for staff: S3. According to S9, S3 left employment on 4/28/17 due to personal reasons.

1715-A.4: Criminal Background Check

NEW 1715-A.4. Based on record review: S3 left the provider's employment for more than 30 days and a new criminal background check was not obtained prior to this individual being re-hired and/or being present on the child care premises (1703.D.2). S3 date of termination/resignation was 4/28/17 and her date of re-hire was 7/21/17. S9 stated S3 left employment for personal reasons.

S7 did receive an additional orientation within 30 days of hire in the required topics.

1907-A.1-2: High Chairs Not Met

- 1. The high chair manufacturer's restraint device shall be used when children are sitting in a high chair.
