1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

- B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.
- C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review: S8 did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not when requested by Specialist at 11:35 a.m. The medication administration training of center staff with this certification expired in May 2020. S8 allowed a staff member not certified in medication administration with an approved CCHC to administer medication. S1 administered medication to C1, a one year old child, on 8/19/2020, 8/19/2020, 8/21/2020, 8/31/2020 and 9/17/2020 without certification in medication administration.

Corrective Action Plan - S8 stated she will have at least two staff trained in medication administration by next week. Staff will be scheduled to take this training on 9/25/2020. S8 stated effectively immediately, staff will not administer medication until certified in medication administration.
