Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review of staff files at 2:15pm, the Provider failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration with an approvied child care health consultant whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 showed Specialist documentation of medication administration training that was not done by an approved child care health consultant.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 09/25/2020, S1, Director, stated she will contact an approved child care health consultant from the list that the Specialist reviewed with her on the Louisiana Believes website.
