Based on record review/interviews: Specialist reviewed staff files during visit on 9/25/19 at 1:45pm, and observed that the center did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 0 of 4 staff had documentation of this certification, however, their certification expired in August 2019. S1 stated that she has a class scheduled for this month.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met
