1915.A.: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915.A.: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915.A. Based on observations/record review: The provider did not document observations, when something is observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. Specialist reviewed observations at 11:00am and found that on 07/29/2019 there was no explanation of the documentation for that day including having a bug bite, scratch on the stomach, bruise on the legs, scratch on the knees, and bug bites on the arm. On 07/31/2019 there was no explanation for scratch on right lower leg, scratch on upper back, and red marks/bumps on chin for one child. There was no documentation at all that observations were done on 07/30/2019 for the toddler 2 class. On 09/20/2019 there were no explanations given for scratch on eyebrow, scratch on knees, bruise on forehead, and light scratch on cheek. On 09/25/2019 there was no explanation for documentations for children with scratches on knees, "above eyebrow", scrape on elbow, scratch on the nose and knee, busted upper lip (cracked), and scratch on the arm.
