Statement of Deficiencies

5312-E.1: CPR

5312.E.1. A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children at all times shall have documentation of current infant/child/adult certification in CPR. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This training shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

Finding:

7312.E.1. (Old Tag #5312.E.1.) The Provider did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children have current approved Infant/Child/Adult certification in CPR. 5 of 15 staff had documentation of this certification.

5312-E.3: PFA

5312.E.3. A minimum of at least 50 percent of all staff on the premises and accessible to children shall have documentation of current pediatric first aid certification. Original cards shall be made available upon request. This certification shall be approved by the Department of Social Services prior to acceptance.

Finding:

7312.E.3. (Old Tag#5312.E.3.) The Provider did not have documentation that at least 50 percent of the staff on the premises and accessible to children at all times has current approved Pediatric First Aid training. 5 of 15 staff had documentation of this certification.

5327-L: Clean of Hazards

5327.L. The center and yard shall be clean and free from hazards.

Finding:

7327.L. (Old Tag#5327.L.) The center were not free of hazards as specialist observed hazards in the following classrooms:

---4 year old classroom:

Located on the right hand side of the classroom there is an cracked electrical plate which is cracked along the top of the outlet, and within reach of the children in this classroom as a child could stick his or her finger into the small 1/2 inch hole and electrocute themselves. The provider pushed a computer desk in the front of the outlet so that children would not have access to the cracked outlet.

Located on the right hand side of the room there is a locked closet door which has it's plywood in disrepair as the pieces of the bottom of the plywood door appear to be a splintering hazard and or the broken pieces could be harmful if swallowed.

---Play yard:

Located on the right hand side of the office to the center has blackberry bushes which are within the fenced in unit, but have grown out of the fenced in perimeter onto the play yard and it's thorns are within the children playing in this area.
