

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1713.E.&F.: Supervision Participation**

**Not Met**

1713.E.&F.:

E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

#### **Finding:**

1713.E.&F: Based on observation/interview/record review: While supervising six 1-2 year old children, S9 and S10 did not devote their time to supervision of the children and in participation with the children in their activities; The Specialist reviewed video footage from 9/20/19 and at approximately 3:58 pm, S9 was observed sitting at her desk writing and sifting through papers, S10 is observed handing S9 a paper then sitting at a table, partially out of view. An incident occurred at 3:59pm, in which C1 was left with two marks on the upper inside of his right arm. S9 completed an incident form stating C1 received a bite to the upper arm and a critical incident form was submitted to the department documented that C1 received a bite. The Specialist did not observe C1 being bitten on the video footage, but did observe C1 playing in between S9's desk, while S9 was seated at her desk, and the cubbie area. After being removed from the area by S9, C1 was seen walking over to S10 while touching the inside of his right upper arm. S10 was seen examining C1's arm then cleaned C1's arm. S9 was putting a poster on the wall, looked up, and walked over to S10 brought C1 over to the desk and also began cleaning C1's arm. Neither S9 nor S10 was sure what happened to C1's arm. The Specialist did not observe C1 being bitten or harmed by any child or staff while viewing the footage.

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
