

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

#### Finding:

1903.C.: Based on observation at 1:55 p.m., the outdoor area failed to be free of hazards. Specialist observed a wooden board, separated from the deck platform, exposing two screws on the toddler play yard. S1 stated she will contact maintenance personnel and provide a picture of repair needed and schedule to have corrected no later than 10/10/2022.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 9/28/2022, S1 stated she will conduct a weekly walk-through of the play yard to observe any hazards and correct, to ensure compliance with this regulation.

### 1911.K.: Hand Washing

Not Met

1911.K.: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911.K.: Based on observations at 1:45 p.m., staff failed to ensure a children washed their hands with soap and water as needed. Specialist observed C3, three-years-old, leave the restroom after toileting, without washing their hands. Specialist alerted S11 and she called C3 to return to the restroom to wash their hands. S22 and 8, two-year-old children, and S9, S20, and 14, one-year-old children failed to wash hands after coming in from outside. Specialist reviewed with staff and hands were washed with soap and water.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 9/28/2022, S1 stated to she will review the regulation with staff. S1 will post hand washing reminders at entry doorways as a visual aid/reminder for staff, to ensure compliance with this regulation.

### 1915.B.&C.: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

1915.B.&C.:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

#### Finding:

1915.B.&C.: Based on record review at 2 p.m., staff failed to have documentation of required immediate notification and/or notification no later than when the child is released on the day of the occurrence, for the following incidents:

- On date and time unknown, a child was scratched on the forehead by another student. The staff signed the report on 7/5/2022.
- On 9/27/2022 at 7:37 a.m., a child's fingers were smashed in the door, causing marks on the fingers. There is no documentation the parent or authorized representative were notified on the day of the occurrence.
- On 9/27/2022 at 10:36 a.m., a child was bit on her chest and it broke the skin. There is no documentation of immediate notification to the parent or authorized representative.
- On 9/28/2022 at 10:58 a.m., a child hit herself on her right eye on a toy container. There is no documentation of immediate notification to parent or authorized representative.
