

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1915.B.&C.: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

#### Finding:

1915.C.: Health Services - Parental Notification: Based on record review at 10:30 a.m., S1 failed to have documentation of immediate notification to the parent when the following occurred to a child:

- On 10/4/2021 at 3:44 p.m., a child hit his head on the bench and the parent was notified at 4:53 p.m.;
- On 9/30/2021 at 4:44 p.m., a child's lip was hit by another child and the parent was notified at 5:31 p.m.; and
- On 8/18/2021 at 2:27 p.m., a child hit his eye with his hand and the parent was notified at 3:40 p.m.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/7/2021, S1 stated she will make immediate contact for all injuries that occur neck and above and document accordingly, to ensure this deficiency is not re-cited.

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
