

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1725-A.-D.: Medication Management Training**

**Not Met**

- 1725-A.-D.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.
- B. Whether administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration.
- C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved Child Care Health Consultant.
- D. A licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

#### **Finding:**

1725-A.-D. Based on record review/interview on 10/17/18, S1 failed to have current documentation of training in medication administration completed with an approved Child Care Health Consultant for at least two staff members, whether administering medication(s) or not as LS observed S1, S6, and S3 medication training was conducted on July 16, 2016. Training is required every two years and the staff's training expired July 16, 2018. S1 stated there were no medications administered within the past licensing year.
