1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on Specialist's record review at 9:45am, S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 3 of 7 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 stated that the staff without PFA training would soon be scheduled to become certified.
