Finding:

1903-C Based on observations on 10/22/2018, the indoor area failed to be free of hazards in the following classrooms:

Classroom #6

Specialist observed a gray box cutter on the bottom shelf of a wooden cabinet located in the back of the classroom. S2 removed the box cutter. Classroom#7

Specialist observed an unlocked gray filing cabinet that contained13 boxes of zip lock bags, 1 can of Red devil rust/protectant, 1 container of lysol disinfectant, 1 bottle of bleach. S2 removed all the items listed and placed them on the very top shelf of the cabinet which was inaccessible to the children. The locking mechanism will be repaired.

Classroom#8

Specialist observed a wooden cabinet that had a child safety locking mechanism but it was not locked. There was a large bottle of rubber glue in the bottom section of the cabinet. S2 removed the items.

Classroom#9

Specialist observed 1 pair of adult scissors on the cabinet in a small plastic basket. S2 removed the items.

Classroom#13

Specialist observed 2 packaging tape dispenser with a sharp cutting edge and 1 pair of adult scissors in a small plastic basket on the shelf. S2 removed the items.

Classroom#14

Specialist observed 2 bottles of bleach in an unlocked closet. The closet was locked.
