Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

## Finding:

1915.A. Based on record review at approximately 2:45pm, S1 failed to document observations, when something is observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented.

- On 10/10/2019, in the toddler 2 classroom, there was no explanation of a child, who had a a scratch on their bottom near their diaper, a child, who had a scratch on his face near his eye, a child, who had bug bites, a child who had a red mark on their arm, and a small scratch on the knee.
- On 10/14/2019, in the toddler 2 classroom, there was no explanation of a child, who had a red mark under his right eye.
- On 10/17/2019, in the toddler 2 classroom, there was no documentation of a child, who had a red mark on their face, a child who had a bruise on his arm, and a child, who had bug bites.
- On 10/18/2019, in the toddler 2 classroom, there was no explanation of a child, who had a scratch by his eye and a child, who had a scratch on his forehead.
