1915 A Based on record review: Staff did document observations, when something was observed, noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented.

- 2. head or neck or eye injury;
- 3. human bite that breaks the skin;

- On 10/18/19 at 10:02am, a child fell and hit her lip on a shelf. The parent was notified at 4:40pm.
- A child was hit on her bottom lip. The parent was notified at 3:15pm on 05/08/219. There in no "time of incident" or "date of incident" documented to determine if notification was immediate'
- A child was bit on the forehead. The parent was notified at 3:20pm on 04/04/19. There was no time of incident documented to determine if the parent was notified immediately.
