

Statement of Deficiencies

1901-J.-K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.-K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-J.-K. Based on observations on 10/23/2018, items that could be harmful to children were observed in the shared children's bathroom located between classrooms #1 and #2. Specialist observed that the wooden changing table located in the bathroom has a broken locking mechanism on the right section of the table. Specialist observed 1 can of Carefree foaming Germicidal Cleaner, 1 can of Carefree Glass Cleaner, and 1 tube of Athlete's foot cream. The items were moved to the left side of the table which has a working locking mechanism. The items observed were not placed in a locked cabinet and the area the items were located was not inaccessible to the children.
