1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification Not Met

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.A.&B.: Based on Specialist's review of records at 11:30am, S8 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. 3 of 7 staff present when Specialist arrived to the center had documentation of this certification. Later during Specialist's visit around 12:15pm, a staff member arrived who had CPR certification, meeting the minimum requirements for CPR certified staff.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C. Based on Specialist's review of records at 11:30am, S8 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 3 of 7 staff present when Specialist arrived to the center had documentation of this certification. Later during Specialist's visit around 12:15pm, a staff member arrived who had PFA certification, meeting the minimum requirements for PFA certified staff.
