1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

1723.A.&B.: Based on observations/record review on at 12:00 p.m., S1 failed to ensure all staff members were trained in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. S1 stated CPR training is currently being scheduled.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/25/2022, S1 stated she will schedule staff around the same time bi-annually to ensure that CPR training is completed for all staff members to ensure compliance with this regulation.

1723.C: Pediatric First Aid

1723.C: C. All staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

1723.C.: Based on observations/record review on at 12:00 p.m., S1 failed to ensure all staff members were trained through pediatric training approved by the department. S1 stated PFA training is currently being scheduled.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/25/2022, S1 stated she will schedule staff around the same time bi-annually to ensure that PFA training is completed for all staff members to ensure compliance with this regulation.

2107.A.1.&2.: Visual Check of Vehicle

2107.A.1.&2.: A visual passenger check of a vehicle is required to ensure that no child is left in the vehicle.

1. A staff person shall physically walk through the vehicle and inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats, and in all enclosed spaces and recesses in the interior of the vehicle.

2. The staff member shall record the time of the visual passenger check and sign the log, indicating that no child was left on the vehicle.

Finding:

2107.A.1.&2.: Based on observations/record review at 12:15 p.m., S1 failed to ensure a visual passenger check of vehicles were completed from 9/02/2022 until current 10/24/2022. S1 stated she and S2 will complete daily visual checks of all vehicles to ensure no child is left in the vehicle.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/25/2022, S1 stated she and S2 will begin completing a different form to ensure compliance with this regulation.
