

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1901-K.&L.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-K.&L.: Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

#### Finding:

1901-K.&L.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children: On 10/25/16 Specialist observed items that can be harmful to children, such as cleaning supplies and chemicals, were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

In S1's classroom there was two pair of adult scissors on top of the back cabinet. S1 also had 3 Lysol sprays, 1 spray can of Raid, 1 spray bottle of Comet, 2 bottle of disinfectant wipes and a bottle of Awesome Cleaning Spray.

In S2's classroom there was one bottle of Lysol wipes.

In S4's classroom there was 4 cans of Lysol spray, 1 can of Lysol Air, 1 unknown chemical agent, and 1 bottle of Lysol Spray Cleaner.

### 1901-Q: Staff Personal Belongings

1901-Q: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

#### Finding:

1901-Q Based on observations: On 10/26/16 Specialist observed the personal belongings of center staff members S2 and S4 was accessible to children. In S2's classroom a purse was on the back counter which was assessable to children. In S4's classroom there was a multicolor computer bag at the teacher's desk and a black purse on the top of the filing cabinet.
