Based on record review/interview(s) at 12:45PM, S7, administered medication to C1 three times a day on 09/30/20, 10/01/2020, 10/02/2020 and once on 10/05/2020 without documentation of training in medication administration. S1 stated training was scheduled in March but she was not able to take it

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/27/2020, S1 will administer medication until S7 can obtain medication administration training to keep this deficiency from being recited.
