

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on Specialist's review of records at 1:45 p.m., S1 failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. 1 of 10 total staff, S7, had a current medication administration training; however, S7 was not present during the inspection.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 10/26/2021, to ensure this deficiency is not recited, S1 stated she will enroll herself and two other staff in a medication administration training course on or before 11/26/2021.
