Statement of Deficiencies

1509-A.10: Computer Practices Policy

Not Met

1509-A.10: Computer Practices Policy that requires computers that allow internet access by children to be equipped with monitoring or filtering software that limits access by children to inappropriate web sites, e-mail, and instant messaging.

Finding:

1509-A.10 Based on record review/interview(s): While the center had a written Computer Practices policy, the Provider failed to equip computers with internet access and used by children with monitoring or filtering software that limits access to inappropriate web sites, e-mail, and instant messaging. Specialist observed computers in the center's classrooms. Specialist inquired with S1 if the computers used by children have internet access and S1 advised that the computers do have internet access. Specialist inquired what type of filtering software is used and S1 responded that there is no filtering software currently in use; however, staff monitor children's computer use and ensure that only sites such as Frogstreet and PBS are accessed by children in care.

1703.B: Visitors - CBC/Accompanied

Not Met

1703.B: An early learning center shall obtain documentation of a satisfactory fingerprint based CBC for each visitor or independent contractor of any kind, prior to the person being present at the center or performing services for the center UNLESS the visitor or independent contractor WILL BE accompanied at all times while on the center premises by an adult, paid, staff member who is not being counted in child to staff ratios, and the center shall have copies of said documentation on-site at all times and available for inspection upon request by the Licensing Division.

1. Documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios who accompanied a visitor or independent contractor at all times while the visitor or contractor was on the center premises shall include the date, arrival and departure time of the visitor or contractor, language stating that the visit or contractor was accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises, and the signature of both the contractor and the accompanying staff member.

Finding:

1703.B Based on record review/interview(s): A satisfactory fingerprint based CBC was not obtained for each independent contractor, prior to the person being present at the center or performing services as evidence by: O4 and O5 were present in the center and there was no documentation of CBC on file for either .The Center did not have documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios who accompanied independent contractor at all times while they were on the center premises. Documentation did not include the language stating that they were accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises and signature of the staff member.
