1919.J.: Bottled Formula/Breast Milk Properly Labeled

Not Met

1919.J.: Bottled formula/breast milk for infants shall be labeled with the child's name.

Finding:

1919.J. Based on interview and record review, Specialist discovered at approximately 12:41pm that S1 failed to ensure that all bottles were labeled with the child's name prior to feeding time. On 10/2/19, C1, who is six month old, was given an unlabeled bottle of breast milk at approximately 4:57pm from C2's storage bin in a refrigerator. According to S15, she used a bottle warmer to warm up a bottle for C1 during his feeding time. She was aware that there was an unlabeled bottle in C2's storage bin, however, she failed to check for a label on the bottle of breast milk prior to giving it to S10. According to S10, she was given the unlabeled bottle by S15 and was aware that there was an unlabeled bottle in C2's storage bin. However, S10 stated that she failed to check for a label on the bottle of breast milk prior to feeding it to C1.
