

Statement of Deficiencies

1721-A. - C.: Continuing Education Training

Not Met

1721-A. - C.: Early learning centers shall provide opportunities for continuing education of staff members. The center staff of Type I centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, shall obtain a minimum of 12 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in §1719(A) and (B). Training shall be conducted by trainers approved by the Licensing Division.

B. These hours are in addition to the 3 hours required for health and safety.

C. Copies of certificates of completion or attendance records shall be maintained at the center and available for inspection by the Licensing Division upon request.

Finding:

1721-A. - C. Based on record review: There was no documentation that the center staff of a Type I centers, excluding Foster Grandparents, obtain a minimum of 3 clock hours of training annually in the topics found in §1719(A) and (B). C. Copies of certificates of completion or attendance records were not maintained at the center and available for inspection by the Licensing Division upon request, ~2 of ~28 staff S-10 & S-11 did not have the required continuing education training. This is in addition to the required training from the Department of Health, Pediatric First Aid and Infant/Child/Adult CPR.
