

Statement of Deficiencies

1903.C.: Free of Hazards

Not Met

1903.C.: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903.C. Based on observations 11:10 am, the center playground failed to be free of hazards as Specialist noted that there was a total of 21 active ant beds on the center playground. Specialist noted there was 1 large ant bed near the direct exit near the tables under the covered area. Specialist noted there was 5 active ant beds located around the black plastic border that surrounds the playground equipment. The remainder of the active ant beds were located in the grassy area on the playground. Specialist noted that the plastic black border that surround the playground equipment had an area that had cracked and broken plastic. There was a total of 4 pieces of the border that was cracked and broken. Specialist noted that 5 of the metal spikes that are used to hold the black plastic border in the ground was sticking up and needed to be hammered down to keep the children from falling onto them. Specialist noted there was a small black tire on the playground that had a metal plate attached to it. Specialist observed that there was black netting that was sticking from under the wood chips under the yellow metal playground equipment with an attached purple slide and under the pink metal jungle gym that posed a tripping hazards to the children. Specialist noted that the grass on the playground needs to be cut. These issues were not corrected prior to Specialist departure.
