

Statement of Deficiencies

1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.B. Based on record review: S1 did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. At approximately 1:11pm, the Specialist observed that 1 of 19 staff, S12, has current medication administration training. S1 stated S21 took the training in August, however they are having an issue getting his certificate

1921.E.: Tornado Drills

Not Met

1921.E.: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921.E. Based on record review: At approximately 1:25pm, S1 failed to have documentation of tornado drills that were completed in March and May 2019. Date of last tornado drills was 6/6/2019. S1 was advised again that a tornado drill must be completed and documented prior to next Licensing visit.
