Finding:

Based on record review: S1 failed to have at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department. One of five staff present had documentation of this certification. There was documentation that S3 completed an on-line CPR course on 05/28/2019 and S5 on 06/03/2019 through American Health Association. American Health Association is not an approved course. S1 stated she is currently scheduling a course for all staff.

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

S1 failed to have at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. Zero of five staff present had documentation of this certification. There was documentation that S3 completed an on-line PFA course on 05/28/2019 and S5 on 06/03/2019 through American Health Association. American Health Association is not an approved course. S1 stated she is currently scheduling a course for all staff.
