

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1725.A.-C.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

1725.A.-C.: A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.

B. Whether the center is administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration and at least one on the premises. A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

#### Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review/interview at approximately 10:30am, S1 failed to have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 stated that she would contact a trainer to schedule a class as soon as possible.

### 1901.G.&H.: Equipment

Not Met

1901.G.&H.: G. All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair.

H. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

#### Finding:

1901.G.&H.:G. Based on observation/interview at approximately 10:15am, all of the center's equipment used by children was not maintained in a safe condition and in good repair. Specialist observed a merry-go-cycle with one right pedal missing on two of the five cycles on the outdoor play yard. S1 stated that she would have maintenance replace the pedals as soon as possible.
