1901-M: Strings and Cords

Not Met

1901-M: Strings and cords, including but not limited to those found on equipment, window coverings, televisions and radios, shall be inaccessible to children under age 4.

Finding:

1901-M Based on observations: Strings and cords were accessible to children under age 4 as Specialist observed an extension card with uncovered electrical sockets and several other cords plugged into the wall, with the numerous cords lying on the the floor, which was accessible to 3-4 year old children during licensing visit on 11/13/2018. Specialist observed on 11/14/2018 that extension cord and cords were tucked behind the toy shelf, but was done after specialist observed it was accessible to the children the previous day.

1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-P Based on observations: The personal belongings of center staff member, S1, was accessible to children. Specialist observed the purse and jacket of S1 lying on a chair in the middle of the room and in addition S1's cellphone out on a desk during licensing visit, accessible to 3-4 year old children.

1903-C: Free of Hazards Not Met

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

1903-C Based on observations: The indoor area in S1's classroom with the 3-4 year old children and S2's classroom with 2-3 year old children, were not free of hazards as uncovered electrical sockets were observed by specialist in several classrooms at center on 11/13/2018. Specialist observed during partial visit that all electrical sockets were covered in both classrooms on 11/14/2018.
