E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

Finding:

1713 E Based on observation: While supervising a group of children, childcare staff did not devote their time to supervision of the children, meeting the needs of the children, and in participation with the children in their activities.

- at 1:23pm, Specialist completed a walk though of the center to during naptime and observed the following:

- S39 and S23 were seated across from each other at a table in the classroom. S23 had her back to the children and was on her cellular phone. S39 was facing toward the children, but was also on her cellular phone with her head down looking at her phone. Specialist did not observe any other teacher in the classroom during naptime.

- S36 and S17 were seated across from each other at a table in the classroom. S17 had her back toward the children. S36 was facing the children, but was on/looking at her cellular phone. Specialist did not observe any other teacher in the classroom during naptime.

Specialist informed S3 and S27 that, even at naptime, staff are to devote their time to supervising children.

The indoor area was not free of hazards as Specialist observed a surge protector on the floor in a classroom plugged into the wall and did not have four of the unused outlets on the surge protector covered with a barrier to protect the children in the class. S3 covered all the outlets during the licensing visit.
