

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1915.B.&C.: Health Services - Parental Notification

**Not Met**

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

#### Finding:

1915. B.&C.: Based on record review/interview: On 10/18/19 at 2:30pm, S7 and S12 observed a scratch on the neck of C1, a 2 year old child, but failed to report the neck injury to O1 immediately. O1 observed and reported a scratch on C1's neck and chest to S13 on 10/18/19 at 4:15pm at the time of pick-up and S13 ensured O1 she would find out what happened to C1.

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
